

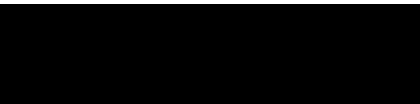

- To be exempted from the English language requirement, English has to be concluded as part of your final school examination. Otherwise:
- You will (im)prove your language proficiency in accordance with the [language requirements](#) of the relevant faculty and provide, within the progress portal, a digitally verifiable copy before **1 September 2026**.
